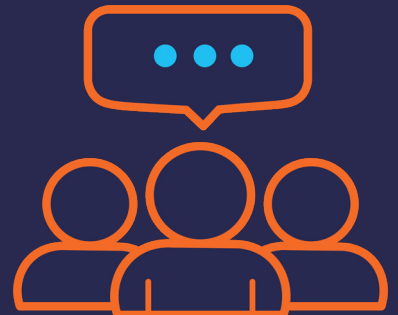


PRIORITIZE
